In 1986, I successfully finished my studies with a dissertation about a surgical topic and received the grade –"Dr. med.". I continued with basic science in kidney and circulation research, followed by a specialized training in gynecology and obstetrics at the I. Frauenklinik der Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München.

Scientifically I worked in the biochemical laboratory, conducting research about ovarian and breast carcinoma as well as inflammatory processes in pregnancy. In 1998, I was awarded the degree "Privatdozent" and started teaching medical students of the Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München in Gynecology. My clinical specialties are gynecological surgeries, (microinvasive endoscopically procedures), focusing on laparoscopic and oncological procedures and surgeries of prolaps. Additionally, I took care of pregnant patients and performed deliveries of normal pregnancies as well as pregnancies with high risk. I furthermore took care of patients with HPV-infections and cervical dysplasia, i.e. patients with abnormal PAP-smear.
